- Organic gardening, soil fertility, the creation of a productive garden and natural pest and disease management.
- Cultivation of traditional vegetables and medicinal plants, including *Artemisia annua*.
- *Artemisia annua* for malaria, HIV, COVID, diabetes and other diseases.
- Preparation of natural medicines from locally available medicinal plants: herbal teas, soaps, oils and ointments, tinctures, cough mixtures and syrups.
- The use of these natural medicines for helping a wide range of health problems including malaria, diarrhoea, wounds and HIV/AIDS.
- Production, value addition and marketing of herbal teas, tinctures and ointments.
- Nutrition and hygiene.
- Construction of simple devices that contribute to health and hygiene such as a charcoal fridge, fuel efficient stoves, black stones, a solar oven, a solar drier and tippy-taps.
- Healing massage.
- Banana management.
