

## We ask for your support in 2021



Discover e.V. aims by March 2022 to bring our support for community development project work to an end. We hope, therefore, to be able to support our partners such that they have the resources and skills to complete their existing projects and to be able to continue their excellent work without financial support from us.

### Immediate needs include

Kasese fishpond project: 104 ponds have been constructed and families are already enjoying harvests of fish for their own consumption and for sale. The water filtration system is proving inadequate, and 10 solar pumps are required to give optimum efficiency. Ten families will share one solar pump.

Cost per pump: 517 Euro / £450

Cost per family: 51.7 Euro / £45

Rehema Namyalo and colleagues will run one final, week-long, intensive training seminar in an area of great poverty for 50 people. Cost per participant: 45 Euro / £39

Obaikol Gideon is providing training for youths from the street in carpentry and natural healthcare.

Cost per participant for food, timber and basic tools: 90 Euro / £78

Monthly rental for storage: 75 Euro / £65

We wish to provide 10 Discover partners the chance to visit and learn from the experience of the Mikwano Farmer Field School in Kaliro.

Cost per person for transport, food, accommodation and tuition fee: 400 Euro / £355

As from March 2022 we shall focus entirely on tree planting, and provide further support for four projects which are already underway:
